Re: Gang Member Sentenced in Homicide

Greeley, CO - On Monday May 16, 2016, Domingo Salazar (d.o.b. 10/17/93), a known gang-member, was sentenced to 30 years in the Department of Corrections after pleading guilty to Attempted Second Degree Murder, a class 3 felony for his role in the gang related homicide of Gumerciendo "Carlos" Munoz. The defendant is one of six co-defendants charged in the death.

The Greeley Police Department began investigating the incident after a call came in on August 15, 2013 with a report of a dead body being found in a home at 2127 5<sup>th</sup> Street, Greeley, CO 80631. Investigators learned that Domingo Salazar and the other co-defendant's confronted the victim at his home about a domestic incident he had the previous night with his girlfriend. The group beat the victim to death with a morningstar.

Two other co-defendants in this case have previously pled and were sentenced. Noel Garcia (d.o.b. 5/5/94) pled to Second Degree Murder, a class 2 felony and Violation of Colorado Organized Crime Control Act, a class 2 felony. Garcia received 50 years in the Department of Corrections. Joel Dominguez (d.o.b. 7/10/95) pled to Second Degree Murder, a class 2 felony. Dominguez was sentenced to 48 years in the Department of Corrections.
