Commonly referred to as the "Fighting 19th," the 19th Judicial District corresponds with the boundaries of Weld County. The "Fighting 19th" is a crime-unfriendly jurisdiction and a place criminals want to avoid—exactly the goal of the office staff. Attorneys in this office have prosecuted numerous dangerous criminals—many of who received long prison sentences. The goal of the office is to make the streets of Weld County much safer for those who live and work here. It is a mission and purpose we strive to meet each day.



Entry level prosecutors are responsible for criminal prosecution of misdemeanor and traffic offenses in County Court, including several categories of higher profile cases. County Court Deputies conduct an average of three jury trials per month, handle other court proceedings, render legal advice to law enforcement officers and perform other related work.

The office uses state-of-the-art technology to prosecute all manner of crimes including homicides, crimes against children, domestic violence, sex assaults and a full range of other criminal activity.

An extensive training program has been established within the office to help new Deputy District Attorneys competently manage a caseload and learn to be trial attorneys. Other specialized training is available to facilitate the professional growth of our attorneys as well.

Career advancement is a priority in our office. Our goal is to make every attorney first chair homicide capable.
