Re: Charges Filed Against Kyle Moore

Greeley, CO – On Tuesday, May 5<sup>th</sup>, charges were formally filed against Kyle Joseph Moore following a police contact on April 9<sup>th</sup>, 2015, which led to a pursuit through west Greeley and subsequent traffic accident at the intersection of 35<sup>th</sup> Avenue and the Hwy 34 Bypass.

Moore was observed in his vehicle in a parking lot to the north of Sanborn Park in Greeley around 6:00pm, and Greeley Police Department officers were advised that he had three outstanding warrants which included an escape charge. When officers in marked police cars approached Moore, he began to flee the parking lot in his vehicle at which time a shot was fired by law enforcement, shattering his window. He collided with another car occupied by a woman and her child. After a brief pursuit, he ran a traffic light, struck another vehicle, and was taken in to custody at 35<sup>th</sup> Avenue and Hwy 34.

Moore is charged with Assault in the Second Degree (F4), Vehicular Assault (F5), Menacing (F5), Vehicular Eluding (F5), Child Abuse (M1), Assault in the Third Degree (M1), and Leaving the Scene of an Accident (T1). Moore's next scheduled court date is May 13, 2015 at 9:30 a.m.

The officer-involved shooting incident remains under investigation by the Weld County District Attorney's Office.

As these are active investigations, no further information or comment can be made at this time.
