We represent all of Weld County, and it is our duty to prosecute individuals charged with committing any crimes within our jurisdiction. The Weld D.A.'s Office has a number of divisions, including specific units for drug and gang cases, special victims and juveniles. We also have a unit entirely dedicated to assisting victims and witnesses of crimes.

TRADITION OF EXCELLENCE

Our office, commonly known as the "Fighting 19th" for our judicial district, is setting a standard of excellence every day. We are a place that criminals actively try to avoid - exactly our goal. During the Michael Rourke administration, attorneys have succeeded in sending countless dangerous criminals to prison and making the streets of Weld County safer.



District Attorney Rourke believes strongly in the importance of crime prevention. His office administers a number of prevention programs, including the Churches Against Senior Exploitation, which empowers our senior citizens to protect themselves against fraud. The office also provides a variety of presentations on white collar crime, identity theft prevention and social media safety and privacy.



We are proud to have Colorado's premiere diversion program. Offering adults and juveniles an individually based alternative to traditional prosecution or a "second chance," the diversion program has over a 95 percent success rate where clients do not repeat their past mistakes, making it their only interaction with the criminal justice system.
