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YOUR RIGHTS AFTER SENTENCING

Victims of crime have a continuing right to certain information after conviction of the defendant. **Upon written request**, the Probation Department, the Weld County Jail, the Department of Corrections, Community Corrections or the Division of Youth Corrections will notify the victim of the defendant's (or juvenile offender's) status. This information includes, but may not be limited to, current location, transfers, escape, or death while in custody, parole hearings and release dates.

You will need to register with the appropriate agency (information listed below) by completing a Post Sentencing Notification Form and mailing it to them. This form will be given to you or mailed to you by the District Attorney's Office Victim Assistance Unit. It is your responsibility to keep the appropriate agencies listed below informed of your current address and phone number(s) at all times.
